Please can we pause the gravy train?

Dear Councillor Kelvin Williams,

I preface this letter by drawing your attention to sections S.1(3)a,b & c of the Protection from Harassment Act 1997. I am reporting crime.

I emailed as many Councillors as I could on 21/5/2023 to say that your appointment to the Crime Panel was totally inappropriate. It is possible that my communications were intercepted. A copy of my letter is at appendix 1.

According to the Post Office's records you received a copy of my 27 page letter (with 37+ appendices on a memory stick) addressed to the Rt. Hon. Huw Merriman M.P. by recorded delivery GK890809609GB at 08.57 on 23/1/24. It was signed for by "Hayes". Unfortunately, Mr. Merriman did not have an opportunity to reply to it before he left office. I will put a copy of my letter to him on www.whatswrongwithwealden.org.uk as well as this letter under the header "Latest lunacy?".

I believe the purpose of the Crime Panel meeting on September 27th 2024 is to approve the re-appointment of Jo Shiner to a senior post within Sussex Police (SP), and our Police & Crime Commissioner (PCC) Katy Bourne (KB) is proposing her re-appointment.

I believe this re-appointment is inappropriate because on her watch an expert witness Mr. M G Wickens F.C.A. was prosecuted in Portsmouth Magistrates Court on 2/9/22 (CPapp17A of the Merriman letter). I attended the trial. Sussex Police personnel and our PCC gave evidence and Sussex Police resources were used. Unfortunately, for some mysterious reason, key evidence that would have scuppered the whole charade was unavailable to the defence and not contributed by SP.

I also attended the trial URN 47EE2948719 of Mr John Hoath in Wimbledon Magistrates Court. His offer to make a citizens arrest without warrant was construed as harassment. Yet the basis of his complaint was seemingly validated in it's entirety by an interview conducted by SP on

20/3/20. Details of this interview was excluded from his appeal in Portsmouth Crown Court (7th - 9th /5/24) which I also attended. It has now been supplied, (after his trial's conclusion but before sentencing), to the Crown Prosecution Service by the Director of Public Prosecutions and it has gone thence to SP (although they already had it). The normal protocol is for the CPS to supply it direct to the defence before trial.

The 20/3/20 interview is at appendix 2. It contains an admission that Jo Shiner, Katy Bourne and Gillian Jones (GJ) should be arrested and prosecuted for drugs, firearms and money laundering offences originating at TN6 1UT. GJ was formerly the force solicitor for Surrey and Sussex. She resigned when it was discovered that she had accessed the Police National Computer (PNC). We do not know whether either of the 20/3/20 interviewers had previously supplied her with their unique access code to the PNC or the date of supply. Perhaps you could interrogate Jo Shiner in public on these points on 27/9/24?

I would urge you not to vote on this re-appointment until the Independent Office for Police Conduct has had an opportunity to investigate. The whole charade would seem to beggar belief but that is no surprise because you will recall it originated with a Wealden planning matter.

At appendix 3 is a letter to Lord Ken Macdonald K.C. who had considerable experience during his tenure as D.P.P. with miscarriages of justice and fantasists.

P.S. Please thank Wealden's Planning Department for returning to file WD/96/0043/LU (after more than two decades) the triple referenced aerial photograph that was removed for the purpose of deceiving Inspector Wilkinson in September 1997. Had it been available to Detective Sergeant Keith Lindsay when he investigated the matter under reference E-42-5942-99 (on a restricted budget that did not allow for a trip to Bristol), he might have concurred with me that your predecessor Ian Kay did indeed deliver a string of eight perjuries. When investigating an identical matter (reported in "The Times" newspaper) about East Dorset D. C., Detective Constable K. Brownless had both the budget and the investigative curiosity to visit the Planning Inspectorate circa March 2000 where he was "allowed to inspect all of the relevant material", however he was not supplied with a tape recording of the actual event as both SP and Wealden were.

P.P.S. Please also ask Jo Shiner whether the Coroners Report on the Bohemia Road Custody Suite death of CT806's prisoner on 12/2/09 has been released to the press yet. JH seems nervous because this parallels his experience in the Hammonds Drive Custody Suite on 1/3/20 when he was rendered comatose whilst underfed in a very cold cell. Apparently the CCTV records became unavailable in both cases. You will appreciate that his demise would have eliminated the architect of live claim HQ16D01540.
